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1. INTRODUCTION

The Essence HDACC II-4K is designed to allow multiple analog/digital audio sources to be controlled, switched and output to a variety of analog/digital audio components. With video bandwidth support up to 18G at 4K2K and audio sampling rate converter up to 384KHz this device has an array of unbeatable features you can't find in any other product on the market. Also it supports 2CH LPCM audio, HDMI, USB Audio 2.0, Optical and Coaxial input/output with both ADC and DAC functions. USB supports DOP (DSD over PCM) decoding, with high sampling frequency to perform high quality conversion and lower the probability of distortion.

For professional applications, the headphone output with built-in amplifier and XLR (Low noise Professional Balance) output offer unparalleled audio quality. Traditional 3.5mm earphone jack analog input and stereo RCA output with a highly accurate PLL and low jitter reduction clock system enables users with total improvement over the original sound. OLED display of sample rates with on-panel and IR remote control provide users with on-the-fly adjustment capability.

4. SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Input source equipment such as CD /DVD /Blu-ray Standard and 4K player or computer via HDMI, USB, Optical or Analog stereo output to amplifier or speaker with analog stereo input. Using USB input, the audio driver from the disc contained on package is needed to install for Windows computer, supported up to Win 10.

6. OPERATION CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS


6.1 Front Panel



- **1 6.3mm HEADPHONE OUT:** This jack is to connect with 6.3mm (1/4") professional headphone so user can enjoy personal listening.
- **2 3.5mm LINE IN:** This is to connect a 3.5mm headphone jack cable from any Smartphone, Digital Audio Player (DAP) or other audio equipment for stereo line in analog audio signal.
- 3 POWER LED: The LED will illuminate red when the device is connected with power supply (standby), and will turn green when you turn on the device.
- 4 IR WINDOW: This is the IR receiver window that accepts IR signal from the remote control of this device that is included in the package.
- **5 OLED:** This OLED displays the in/output selection with volume setting, sampling rate and audio channels.

6 MENU/VOLUME CONTROL: Press this control knob to enter into the menu selection or rotate to adjust the volume.

6.2 Rear Panel



- 1 DC 5V: Plug the 5V DC power adaptor included in the package into the unit and connect the adaptor to an AC outlet for power supply. The adapter is automatic and universal, working on all voltages worldwide and comes with 4 adapter plugs to suit any required connection.
- 2 HDMI IN 1~4: Connect up up to 4 HDMI sources such as DVD/ Bluray Standard / Blu-ray 4K player with 18G HDMI signal transmission over high speed HDMI cable. 18G signals are supported on all 4 ports.
- 3 HDMI OUT: Connect to UHD 4K HDTV/monitor for output image display with 18G HDMI signal transmission from high speed HDMI cables.
- 4 COAX. IN: Connect input source equipment such as Cable Broadcast or Satellite Set-Top-Box, PS3, CD for input audio signal transmitted over Coaxial cable.
- **5 OPT. IN:** Connect input source equipment such as DVD/Blu-ray player for input audio signal transmitted via Optical cable.
- **6 USB IN:** This slot is to connect with PC/Portable digital players and server sources for USB audio signal input. This slot is also for firmware upgrades, supported up to Win 10.
- **OCAX. OUT:** Connect to amplifier or active speaker with coaxial cable.



- **8 OPT. OUT:** Connect to amplifier or active speaker with optical cable.
- L/R OUT: Connect to amplifier or active speaker with RCA jack cable.

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

- **XLR (L/R) Balanced OUT:** These slots are to connect to amplifier or directly to professional active speakers with XLR cables, allows for the use of long cables while reducing susceptibility to external noise.


6.3 Top Panel



- 1 POWER: Press this button to switch on the device or turn it to standby mode.
- 2 MUTE: Press this button to mute all volume instantly.

6.4 Remote Control

- 1 POWER: Press to turn the unit power on or set to standby mode.
- 2 MENU: Press the key to enter OSD menu, use V+/V- to go up and down between the menu selections, press again to enter submenu.
- **3 RETURN:** When in the menu, press this to go back upper layer or exit from menu selections.
- 4 VOLUME +/-: Press V+ / V- to control output volume up and down. When press MENU key into menu selections, use V+ / V- to go up and down menu selections.



- **5 MUTE:** Press this button to mute all audio volume, press again to unmute.
- 6 HDMI 1~4: Press these hot keys to select HDMI input sources from 1~4.
- **7 COAX.:** Press this hot key to switch input source to Coaxial input.
- 8 OPT.: Press to select Optical input.
- **9 USB:** Press to select USB input.
- 10 LINE: Press to select LINE input.

6.6 Firmware Updates

This unit provides a simple and easy way to update the firmware via the USB port. Updating the firmware requires access to a standard Windows XP or later PC/Laptop.¹

¹ Units with a firmware before v2.23 can only be updated on Windows XP, 7, 8, or 8.1 PCs. Updating in Windows 10 from those earlier firmware versions is not supported. Beginning with firmware version v2.23, firmware update support within Windows 10 has been added.

Update Procedure:

- 1. Power the unit on and using the unit's front panel, navigate, using the Menu Knob, to the ">Firmware" menu item and select it. The current firmware version will be displayed.
- 2. Turn the knob until the unit displays ">Update?" and press the knob in to select it. The following information will show on the unit's display:





3. Connect the unit to your Windows PC via USB. The Windows PC will detect the unit as a USB storage device. Open up Windows Explorer and you will see a new USB storage device named "USB UPDATER" in the drive list. (Note: The drive letter assigned will vary from PC to PC, depending on the number of drives already existing on the PC.)



- 4. Copy the new firmware file (*.bin format) onto the "USB UPDATER" drive. Once the file copy is complete the power light on the unit will begin blinking rapidly and then the unit will automatically power off. (Note: If an invalid file is copied to the unit, the update process won't start and the unit will need to be manually rebooted by unplugging the power.)
- 5. Power the unit back on and verify that the desired new firmware version is displayed.
